



Fillmore County Board Minutes



March 25, 2016

The Fillmore County Board of Supervisors convened in open and public session at 9:00 a.m., March 25, 2016, in the Courthouse Boardroom in Geneva, Nebraska with Chairman Cerny presiding. Members present were Noel, Capek, Galusha, Neiman, and Johnson. Mueller was absent. The County Clerk was present to record the minutes of the meeting. Judy Glassburner; Harold (Butch) Long; County Attorney, Jill Cunningham; and County Sheriff, Bill Burgess were present for the meeting.

Notice of the meeting was given by posting. A copy of the publication is on file in the County Clerk's office. All proceedings hereinafter shown were taken while the convened meeting was open to the public. Agenda was approved as presented. The Chairman noted that the public meeting guidelines are posted as required by law and available for public distribution if requested. The meeting adjourned at 9:06 a.m.

RECOMMENDATION FROM VETERANS SERVICE BOARD OF VETERANS SERVICE OFFICER
