Notice is hereby given that on Tuesday the 12th day of May, 2020 at the polling places in the election precincts of Fillmore County, Nebraska, an election will be held. The polls will open at 8:00 a.m. and close at 8:00 p.m. Said election will be for nominating candidates to various offices. Some races will not appear on the Primary Election ballot as the number of candidates filing does not exceed twice the number of vacancies; these candidates are declared nominated and advance to the November 3, 2020 General Election. Voters living in school districts that cross county lines will be voting on candidates and special issues in their respective districts. Proposed Constitutional Amendment, title and text to be published by the office of the Secretary of State, once a week for three weeks prior to the Primary Election.

Village of Milligan Sales Tax Ballot Question

"Shall the Board of Trustees of the Village of Milligan, Nebraska, impose a sales and use tax upon the same transactions within such municipality on which the State of Nebraska is authorized to impose a tax for street and water system repairs and upkeep under the following terms and conditions?

1. The sales tax revenue generated by the 1.5% local sales and use tax shall be used for: (a) street rehabilitation or reconstruction of existing streets in the Village to maximize their useful life, enhance safety, streamline traffic flow, or promote private sector investment; and (b) maintenance, rehabilitation or reconstruction of existing water system structures to improve the Village's access to water. The revenues from the 1.5% local sales and use tax shall not be used to support or pay back any city issued bonds.

2. The street and water system projects funded by the 1.5% local sales and use tax shall be determined by the Village of Milligan Board of Trustees to ensure that these tax revenues are spent fairly, efficiently, and effectively.

3. The Village of Milligan Board of Trustees shall publish an annual report on projects funded by the 1.5% local sales and use tax for each year that the tax is in effect for the purposes set forth herein.

4. The 1.5% local sales and use tax rate will be implemented and related revenues collected beginning on October 1, 2020, and continue indefinitely.

5. If a majority of the votes cast upon such question shall be in favor of such tax, then the Village of Milligan Board of Trustees shall be empowered to, as provided by NEB. REV. STAT. 77-27,142, and shall forthwith proceed to impose a tax pursuant to the Local Option Revenue Act.

6. If a majority of those voting on the question shall be opposed to such tax, then the Village of Milligan Board of Trustees shall not impose such a tax."
