Board of Equalization Reorganization Meeting

The Fillmore County Board of Equalization convened to reorganize, as required by statute, in open and public session at 9:15 a.m. on January 7, 2021, in the Courthouse Boardroom in Geneva, Nebraska. Members present were Noel, Sluka, Graham, Neiman, Harre, Cerny, and Lightwine. The County Clerk was present to record the minutes of the meeting.

Notice of the meeting was given by publication. A copy of the publication is on file in the County Clerk's office. All proceedings hereinafter shown were taken while the convened meeting was open to the public. Agenda was approved as presented. The Chairman noted that the public meeting guidelines are posted as required by law and available for public distribution if requested. The reorganization meeting adjourned at 9:20 a.m.

NOMINATIONS OF CHAIRMAN
