BOE December 14, 2021

The Fillmore County Board of Equalization convened in open and public session at 9:00 a.m., December 14, 2021, in the Courthouse Boardroom in Geneva, Nebraska with Chairman Neiman presiding. Members present were Noel, Sluka, Graham, Cerny, Harre, and Lightwine. The County Clerk was present to record the minutes of the meeting.
